Re: Debt Owed To The State of Ohio

Dear Sir or Madam,

As you know the State of Ohio has the right to file post judgment collection proceedings against you and your assets because of the delinquent tax accounts noted above. This letter will confirm the agreement not to do so at this time, provided you do the following:

1. Make the payments as described on the next page.
2. You agree that the State of Ohio may commence an initial action to collect these taxes at any time in the future in the event you breach this payment agreement or taxes remain due at the conclusion of the agreement.

Failure to agree may result in the filing of post judgment collection proceedings against you or your assets. You must return a signed copy of this letter to prevent these proceedings. This agreement prevents civil proceedings against you. It does not affect any jurisdiction's right to take criminal action against you for the nonpayment of tax, nor does it prevent the filings of liens or income tax or lottery award offsets.
