

What you need to do

You don't need to take any action at this time. Be sure to:

- File all future tax returns and pay any amount(s) you owe on time.
- Consider making voluntary payments toward the amount(s) you owe, when possible, to minimize additional interest and applicable penalties.

What you need to know

Although we temporarily closed your case for collections, you still owe the IRS an amount(s). We may re-open your case in the future if your financial situation improves. Because you still owe the IRS an amount(s), we'll continue to add applicable penalties and interest to your account and we can make other adjustments and offsets, such as applying future federal tax refunds to the amount(s) you owe. Additionally, your state tax refunds may be subject to levy under the State Income Tax Levy program (SITLP). Furthermore, if your case is re-opened, the IRS will notify you to resolve your federal tax debts. If your federal tax debts are not resolved after repeated notifications, the IRS could issue a levy or file a Notice of Federal Tax Lien or potentially certify you to the Department of State for denial or revocation of passport.
